In recent terms, many of the most important and interesting cases were not added to the Supreme Court's docket until the late September "long conference" or thereafter. The Court has already agreed to hear an explosive case challenging dues from non-union teachers, which one of our panelists will argue. The Court will also hear the return of the *Fisher v. University of Texas* racial preference case, a constitutional challenge to the inclusion of non-citizens in districting, and another challenge to Arizona's redistricting commission, the last of which another panelist will argue.
